Psychic **Ruth** talks about how much she enjoys working for Crystal Clear Psychics

Crystal Clear Psychics: *When did you first discover you were psychic?*

Ruth: *Everyone is psychic to a degree, although that degree varies greatly. Instead of discovering I was psychic, I discovered other people could sense the same frequency, though they didn't necessarily tune in to the same signal strength I could. This holds as true as ever today, as many clients sense something is coming up.*

CCP: *What are your talents and what do they mean? I.e. Clairvoyant? Clairsentient? Medium etc?*

Ruth: *First off is clairvoyance. Everyone has it, though few realise it. Movies flash through your mind all the time. Pictures, too. While many will be a result of your memory, some flash by while you're pondering a situation unfolding. The trick is to slow those movies down so you can watch what unfolds and interpret it as a past, present, near future, or future event. Everyone has clairsentience, too. I've never run across a client lacking the ability to feel what other people in their life are dealing with or experiencing. But, as with any psychic ability, there are blind spots. Those blind spots usually extend to family, self, and lovers. Claircognisance affects us all from time to time. Maybe an old friend's name surfaces in your mind, and you, understanding the signal sent, interpret it correctly and wind up hearing from them the same day. You might decide to do something sweet for your significant other and pick up their favorite treat on the way home from work, only to find, when you arrive home, that they were thinking about the exact treat you bought before you bought it!*

Ruth: *While I can read Tarot and Native American Medicine Cards, and adore astrology and numerology, it's extremely rare that I use any of these tools in a reading unless it's requested – and it never is. I depend on what I get in my head first. Clients are spending their hard earned money to get information quickly and concisely. It's on me to make that connection clear from the very beginning of their call. There are millions of psychics for a reason. I can't connect with everyone, nor will they feel a connection with me. For that reason, I get going immediately so we can see if I have a legitimate connection or not. If not, they don't pay for the call, and have the opportunity to see if they connect with another reader who gets it right from the beginning.*

CCP: *One remarkable story from a recent client?*

Ruth: *A recent client had a business that was doing quite well, winning awards and garnering high praise, but he was burned out and convinced he couldn't keep at it any longer. I pointed out he had a huge idea lurking somewhere in his head. One that could make him much more than the business he was currently operating. Also, had he considered acquisition? Turned out he hadn't. He'd been too busy running on the treadmill to think about what he wanted. And no, he'd never thought of selling his company, though a well-known company had been in touch with him a few months prior. More exciting still was that he did have a big idea, and after the acquisition he started working on it with huge interest from well-known names who are lining up to invest when he gets the prototype up and working.*

Halloween

The ancient Celtic festival of *Samuin* or *Samhain* meant 'summers end' and was the first and most important festival of the year, held on October 31st.

In northern Europe, this festival marked the beginning of the darker months and the dangers confronting survival were very real. It was the beginning of the Celtic New Year and cattle and people were purified by walking through two large bonfires.

Known as a 'day between the years' or an *Ysbrydnos*, it was a magical night where the dead were said to walk among the living and the veils between the living and dead were lifted in prophecy and divination.

The Norse celebrated this time as *Vetnaetr*, the Anglo Saxons called it *Vuinter Fylleth* meaning winter approaching; for the Welsh it was the night of the winter calends and in Ireland, it was Goblin or Puca night. It was a time of remembering the dead and marking the time with offerings to the Gods, drinking and feasting.

The Manx celebrate *Hop tu Naa* at this time meaning 'this is the night' and traditionally the turnip lanterns known as Jack o'lanterns were carried; this tradition carried over to America where pumpkins were grown and hollowed more easily and provide the lanterns we recognise so easily today.

Common traditions that still take place at this time include leaving food out for the spirits, salt placed on doorways and windows to keep evil at bay, pumpkins or turnips hollowed out and lit, apple bobbing (from the recent apple harvest) and dressing up as the spirits we

think we might see! Sweets have replaced the soul cakes which were taken by children from door to door requesting them.

All forms of divination take place at this time and used to include the casting of nuts into the fire – how they sprung out would determine your fortune! Gazing into a mirror at certain times at night would also reveal future lovers and apple peel was often cast into the fire as a question was asked – how it fell would reveal a pattern that would give you the answer.

Crows and ravens, long associated with omens and prophecy are the sacred animals of Halloween, as are black cats, owls, bats and all the creatures of the night. Certainly the fear of witchcraft in the middle ages, added the familiar figure of the witch on her broomstick, accompanied by her familiars!

And so the great festival of Samhain continues to evolve and yet the core remains the same; confronting the unknown and our own fears; celebrating coming together for the strength and comfort found in community, families and friends and now, in modern times, emerging to a more spiritual symbolic focus of finding our inner light to sustain us through our own 'dark' times.

The dark has had a bad press over the years, symbolising something to be feared and yet, it is from the dark that the light and life grows; the baby in the womb, the seed in the earth, the dawn after the night. The winter allows the earth to rest and the night allows us to retreat and recover our strength - so let us celebrate the dark, the unknown and the hidden in this most enchanting of festivals!
