WHEN DID YOU FIRST DISCOVER THAT YOU WERE PSYCHIC?

I became aware of psychic realities and I first became aware of my psychic ability as a small child, on holiday with my family in Sussex. Entering the crypt of Arundel Castle, I felt such an overwhelming sense of cold and sadness that I started to cry. An old woman approached. She touched my face and said to my father, 'Don't worry, she's a sensitive.' Afterwards, I understood I had been picking up on all the feelings of those buried there. WHAT ARE YOUR TALENTS AND WHAT DO THEY MEAN?

I am clairvoyant, so that by simply speaking to someone, I'm able to pick up on their thoughts, feelings or current situation—as well as the direction in which their life is heading. Sometimes this may take the form of an image flashing into my head that has relevance for the client, or it may simply be something I just know to be true. I am also clairaudient, which means I can hear—on a psychic level—conversations or messages from loved ones about what is going on for that person in terms of their career and relationships. I also have the ability to work with pets and to pick up on their moods and behaviour.

WHAT TOOLS DO YOU USE AND WHY? WHAT IS THEIR HISTORY?

I love to use colour cards when doing readings. The effect of colour on our lives is nothing new. The ancient Egyptians understood the healing properties of colour and built halls in the sacred temples at Karnak and Thebes dedicated to its power. Recent scientific research has since proved that the electromagnetic frequency of colour has different effects on different parts of the body, can influence our moods, and can even restore balance and harmony to our lives.

CAN YOU TELL US ONE REMARKABLE STORY FROM A RECENT CLIENT?

One client I spoke to about a month ago was very emotionally upset. Not having had colour cards read for her before, she didn't believe they could help. Few saw it coming. An actor—one who was better known for his striking good looks, comedic turns and romantic comedy appeal—suddenly becomes one of the most respected names in Hollywood.

The world even invents a word for it: McConaissance. His story becomes one of reinvention and redemption in an industry where few are able to escape the past and make a clean start.

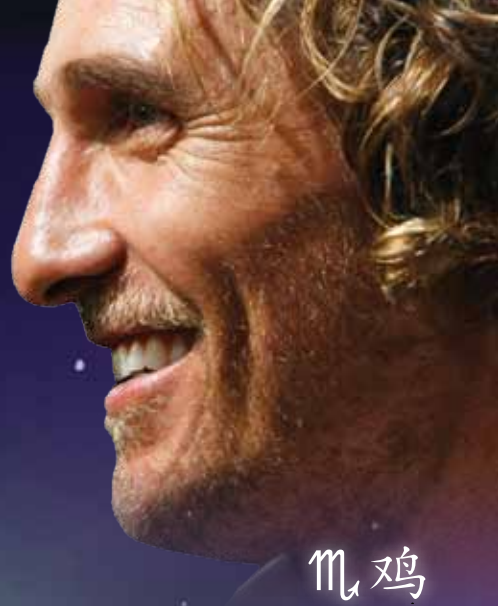
Matthew McConaughey's arrival into the acting elite is indeed a surprise to audiences and critics—yet both groups have embraced it. The question is, why? It could be explained by a lot of hard work, some good decisions, and quite a few lucky breaks. But it's also possible that McConaughey's psychic qualities and astrological signature have played a crucial part—and that Spirit itself has opened the door to this new chapter in his career and life.

Matthew David McConaughey was born on the 4th of November, 1969. As a Scorpio born in the Chinese year of the Rooster, his sex appeal is boosted by a proud, visceral intensity. There's an early scene in his first feature film—*Dazed and Confused*—where he enters a crowded high school hangout in slow motion. His confident swagger exudes Scorpio sexuality and Rooster pride, but there's more to it than that. We also sense an emotional depth and a heartfelt sense of loyalty in his seemingly superficial character.

As a native Texan, McConaughey had what could be considered an All-American upbringing. He was raised Methodist, played sports from a young age, and was voted by his high school classmates as "most handsome student." But he wasn't really interested in acting until he graduated from the University of Texas with a degree in Radio-Television-Film. At that point, he realized he didn't want to attend law school as planned—and indeed, fate had other things in mind. On the heels of his cult performance in *Dazed and Confused*, McConaughey was cast in *A Time to Kill*. He may not have become a lawyer in real life, but he did play a lawyer in his first performance as a Hollywood leading man.

There were other serious roles in the 1990s and into the 2000s—such as *Contact*, *Amistad*, *Frailty* and *U-571*. But by 2004, McConaughey fell into a comfortable groove of romantic comedies. It worked, audiences loved it, and the paychecks were big. But the now-famous actor wasn't really satisfied. Scorpio is too deep and dark, and the Rooster too proud, to stay forever in the land of lighthearted date movies. Around 2010, McConaughey began to ask himself how he could escape the career momentum he had created. His answer was to begin turning down the roles he had become famous for, knowing that he would have to live through a period without any work at all.

Things began to change within two years. McConaughey had always demonstrated a commitment to work that was deep and intense, and this was not lost on the industry's most talented directors. Once the rom-com sheen began to fade from the public mind, the actor became an interesting option for serious films. *Killer Joe*, *Magic Mike* and the universally-acclaimed *Mud* marked the beginning of what people began to call the McConaissance. Things reached a fever pitch when McConaughey claimed a Best Actor Academy Award in 2013, for his portrayal of a Texas cowboy diagnosed with AIDS in *The Dallas Buyers Club*.

When we see McConaughey's name attached to a project now, we think big budgets, big directors, and serious drama—and it's not just the performances. Millions are inspired by the actor's story of redemption and renewal. It reminds us of what's possible in our own lives when we let our inner nature shine—even if it means taking big risks in the process.

SUPERCARGE YOUR INTUITION

In today's fast-moving world, most of us are constantly charging things. Our phones, our laptops, even our watches.
